STAMPS HELP SHARE THE HISTORY OF THE WORLD

After seeing the American flag hoisted for the first time on his ship, Captain William Driver proclaimed "My ship, my country, and my flag, Old Glory." His mother gave the flag to him for his 21st birthday. After he retired to Nashville thirteen years later, he continued to display the flag proudly on his property. He even updated the flag in 1861 to reflect 34 stars and added an anchor to tribute his sea service.

After Tennessee seceded from the Union, Driver had his daughter sew the flag inside a quilt to hide it from the many raids on his house. Old Glory remained in the quilt until February 25, 1862, when Ulysses S. Grant captured Fort Donelson and occupied Nashville. That is when Driver uncovered the flag, marched to the capital building, climbed to its dome, and hung the flag for all to see!
